

N96 Backup Instructions

Australian Digital Testing Trial (OPTUS)


On Device Backup


Note: You must have a Memory Card Inserted to Backup On Device.


- Press the **Menu** key, then **Tools > File mgr. > Backup**
- You will be presented with an item headed **Backup Contents**
- Press **Change** and you will be presented with a list of items to backup
- Choose the items you want backed up then press **OK**
- Press **Options > Back up now**
- You will be presented with a pop-up window stating: **Create backup on F: Memory Card?** Press **Yes**. The backup will now be created.
- To restore the data if required, press **Menu > Tools > File mgr. > Backup > Options > Restore** and follow the prompts.


PC Suite Backup

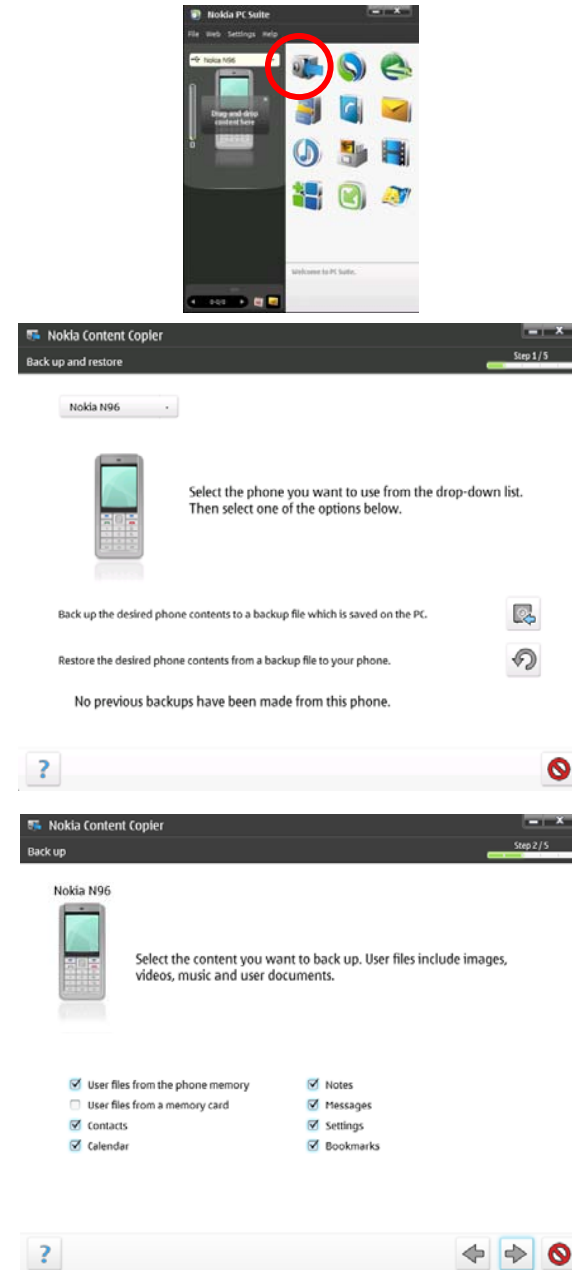
- Firstly, have PC Suite installed on your Windows XP or Vista Computer.
 - PC Suite comes loaded on the CD in your sales pack, or
 - The latest version can be downloaded from <http://www.nokia.com.au/A4630619>
- Connect your N96 using the USB cable supplied in the Nokia pack you received at the time of purchase and select **PC Suite** once the pop-up window appears.
- If this is the first time you have connected to your PC, there will be a group of files installed to enable your phone to be accessed by PC Suite.

- Click on the PC Suite Icon on your desktop 


- The PC Suite window will open and select the backup icon 


- The content copier window will now open and to start the backup process click on the  icon

- The next window presents you with a list of items to backup, check each one you want backed up and then, press  at the bottom of the window.



- You will now be asked where you want to save the backup file and to give it a name. It is probably better to save the file to your Windows Desktop.

Click the “browse” tab  to set where you want to save the file and under what name.

Click on  and the backup will start.

- Now follow the prompts and wait for the backup to finish before disconnecting your N96.
